- Factory assembled; Transportable; Designed for transportation on own chassis; Can be placed on temporary or permanent foundation; Intended for year-round occupancy
- Note: Modular homes are considered residential single family homes.

Your electric cooperative reserves the right to approve, deny or select the appropriate incentive. Prior approval from your electric co-op is required for electric resistance incentives.

To qualify, the home in which the equipment is installed must be occupied year-round and an energy management switch must be installed on rebated equipment.

To receive an incentive from your cooperative, homeowners must provide AHRI (Air conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute) validation for all SEER ratings. This can be obtained from the installing heating and cooling dealer. No incentive will be awarded based on SEER rating listed on the HVAC dealer bid specifications, promotional material of dealer, manufacturer or any other source than AHRI.

Homeowners must complete a request form and provide proof of purchase (invoice or receipt) to receive any 2017 incentive.

Deadline to apply for 2017 Rebate Program is Dec. 15, 2017.

Appliance Recycling

- \$50 per appliance rebate
- Must be a working refrigerator or freezer between 10 and 30 cubic feet
- Residential only, no commercial
- Limit of two appliances per household

Dual Fuel Touchstone Energy Home

- Same construction requirement for all-electric Touchstone Energy Home
- Requires ≥90% AFUE fossil fuel furnace with 100% combustion air coming from outside
- Requires ≥16 SEER heat pump
- Requires electric water heater
- No guaranteed heating costs
